	Complete Grade 12, with one credit in each of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grade 12 English</li> <li>• Grade 12 Applied Math or Pre-Calculus Math</li> <li>• Grade 12 Chemistry or Physics</li> </ul>
	6 credits of Human Anatomy and Physiology (completed within the last 5 years)
	3 credits of Medical Terminology (completed within the last 5 years)
	Complete an English language assessment or the DRP
	Full Stage Driver's Licence
	Complete a Basic Life Support (BLS Provider) first aid course (minimum 4 hours)
	Complete the CASPer Test (limited schedule). Your results will be sent directly to RRC.
	Complete the CASPer Snapshot (limited schedule). Your results will be sent directly to RRC.

	Transcripts of your complete education including high school and post-secondary
