FULL-TIME PROGRAM APPLICATION

KNOW BEFORE YOU APPLY

You are required to submit an application form and a \$100 non-refundable/ non-transferable application fee for each program you apply to. Payment of this application fee does not guarantee you admittance into your chosen program or a requested start date.

There is no application fee for the following programs: Academic Foundations, Grade 11, Grade 12, Introduction to Business, and English as an Additional Language.

If you've previously been informed by the College that you have an outstanding account or are on suspension, etc, you must meet the requirements outlined by the College before you apply. Should you choose to apply before meeting the requirements, your paid application fee may not be refunded or may be applied to any outstanding fees.

Applicants must meet all College and program admission requirements.

Admission preference is given to Manitoba residents who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents (landed immigrants).

Generally, you are a Manitoba resident if Manitoba is where you have lived for the last twelve consecutive months before applying to the College. Manitoba residents who temporarily spent time outside of Manitoba in post-secondary studies are still considered Manitoba residents.

Applications received from non-Manitoba residents for programs designated as 'Manitoba residents only' will be cancelled. The application fee will not be refunded.

SUBMISSION OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Failure to submit required documentation within the required timelines will result in your application being cancelled with no refund of the non-refundable/non-transferable application fee.

All supporting documentation must be in English or French, or have English translations attached. The documents must be legible.

Your application form, transcripts, and other documentation submitted become the property of the College.

However, if you apply within 6 weeks of the start date of the program, required documentation is due within 5 days of applying.

1. Confirmation Of Enrolment - Interim Transcript Required

For most programs you may apply while enrolled in the required high school and/or post-secondary courses if you are able to submit:

- 1. An interim transcript confirming enrolment in the required courses within 30 days of applying.
- **2.** A final transcript by July 15 or the deadline specified in your admission letter.

However, some programs require successful completion of the required courses and submission of a final transcript within 30 days of applying. See your program's admission requirements for details.

Confirmation Of Completion - Official Final Transcript Required You must submit your official final transcript(s) as proof of completion of

admission requirement courses.

We require verification of your complete academic history including any public or private high school, college, university, or technical institutes you have attended.

High School - After submitting and paying for your application, you will be sent an e-mail confirming whether or not your high school participates in electronic grades transfer. If you did not provide your MET number, or if your school does not participate in electronic grades transfer, you must submit your official high school transcript. High school transcripts may be submitted by you. They must be originals printed on school letterhead, signed by a school official, and sealed with the school seal. Faxes are not acceptable.

Post-Secondary - If you have attended a post-secondary institution including any public or private college, university, or a technical institute, we require submission of your official post-secondary transcripts even if the Red River College program you are applying to does not require post-secondary courses as an admission requirement. Post-secondary transcripts must be dated within the past 6 months and submitted in a sealed envelope directly from the post-secondary institution. Faxes are not acceptable.

2. Proof Of Completion Of Various Other Program Admission Requirements (if applicable)

Many programs require completion of other admission requirements. Examples include:

- Proof of completion of immunizations for health provider programs
- Evidence of successful completion of a prescribed English Skills
 Assessment at the required competency level for the Nursing program
- Verification of completion of volunteer hours for the Animal Health Technology program

Before applying, ensure you have thoroughly reviewed your program's admission requirements. After applying, your admission requirements will be listed as 'supplemental items' within your online account.
