WHAT IS TECHNICAL VOCATIONAL TEACHER EDUCATION?

Technical Vocational Teacher Education is a 90-credit hour part-time program with continuous entry. The program is designed to develop the knowledge and skills required for Technical Vocational Teacher certification by Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning. The program makes up the first three years of the five-year joint RRC Polytech/ University of Winnipeg Bachelor of Education degree with a major in Vocational Education. Upon successful completion of this program, graduates will receive a diploma from RRC Polytech and will be eligible for a Permanent Technical Vocational Teaching certificate issued by Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning. COURSE DELIVERY OPTIONS

For the 2023-2024 academic year, courses will be offered using synchronous online learning with the Microsoft Teams application. Some classes may be scheduled with optional on-campus activities that will be determined by the instructor.

Synchronously online: Learners participate in course-related activities using a web-based video conferencing tool like MS Teams or Webex. Learners are required to connect to live/synchronous sessions where they will participate in learning activities with the instructor and other learners. In this delivery method there will also be some independent commitments guided by the course schedule. Both components are required and may not be taken separately.

REQUIRED TECHNOLOGY, EQUIPMENT AND AVAILABILITY

To participate in courses offered online students must have: **Type A Device: Standard**

The majority of RRC Polytech programs where laptops are required will fall under one of two levels of specification - Type A Device: Standard or Type B Device: Power. Standard (Type A) devices will meet the requirements for most programs.
